



Promoting local/seasonal eating.


Empowering residents to grow their own.

- Aim: to develop projects and activities that contribute to a vibrant and sustainable local community
- PLANT set up in 2011 as a gardening and environmental sub-group
 - ➤ To grow food
 - ➤ To take practical actions to combat climate change
 - To enhance Tayport's natural environment.



PLANT – The Community Garden


- Inclusive

Gracemount Community Garden



We work with local people and community organisations to regenerate greenspaces and community buildings by:

- Running community health, learning, food growing and volunteering programmes and events that reduce social isolation, mental ill health and poverty, improve health and community connections, increase bio-diversity and reduce carbon pollution.
- Increasing opportunities for volunteering and supporting local grassroots projects
- Working with local residents and community organisations to develop the buildings and greenspaces where we are based and in surrounding communities
- Working to improve the environments where we are based, by tackling the impacts of climate change, reducing carbon pollution, increasing bio-diversity, and promoting sustainable development and regenerative horticulture

- Currently working with Friends of the Mansion to develop the buildings and greenspaces surrounding the garden.

- Also working with a range of statutory and voluntary agencies to support local community greenspace projects across South Edinburgh.
- University of Edinburgh Community Grants funding for Our Gracemount community action research and volunteering project
